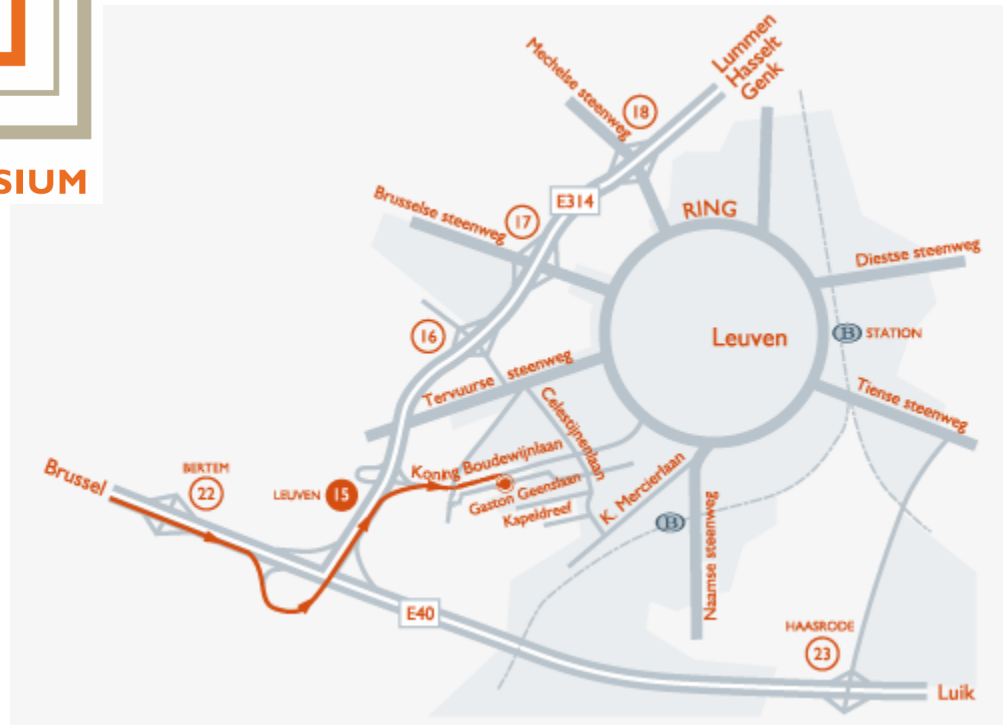




How to reach us?



- **By car**

Essensium is located in Heverlee, Leuven at approximately 25 km from Brussels and its International Airport "Zaventem". It takes half an hour drive by car to reach Essensium from Brussels, capital of Belgium. Leuven lies at the intersection of two highways, the E40 highway London (GB) - Brussels - Liège - Köln (Germany) and the E314 highway Leuven-Hasselt-Aachen (Germany). Once leaving the highway E314 on exit 15, turn right at the second traffic lights ("Wetenschapspark"), leading into the Gaston Geenslaan.
- **By train**

Leuven is situated along the international railroad London (GB) - Brussels - Liège - Köln (Germany). If you are traveling from another direction than the ones mentioned above, a changeover at Brussels' North, Central or South Station is needed to reach Leuven.

If you are coming from Brussels airport, take the underground station located in the airport building. There are every 30 minutes direct trains that will bring you to Leuven in about 15 minutes.

- **By bus**

From Leuven station or downtown Leuven city, bus 616 will bring you to the Wetenschapspark in Heverlee. The busstop is situated just opposite of the Essensium building.
